Proclamation

WHEREAS, the winning organization will be decided by total money raised by Noon Central Standard Time on Super Bowl Sunday, February 6, 2011; and,

WHEREAS, the losing organization must change its Facebook page to reflect support of the winning organization's home team during the Super Bowl and that organization's leader must videotape a message to the others' supporters, while dressed in the home team's swag; and,
